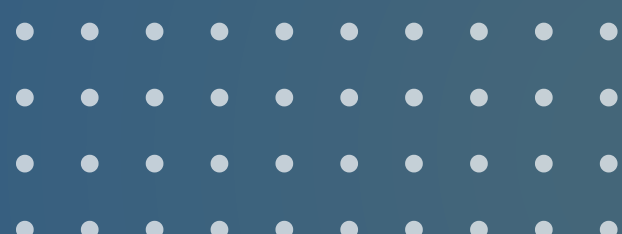




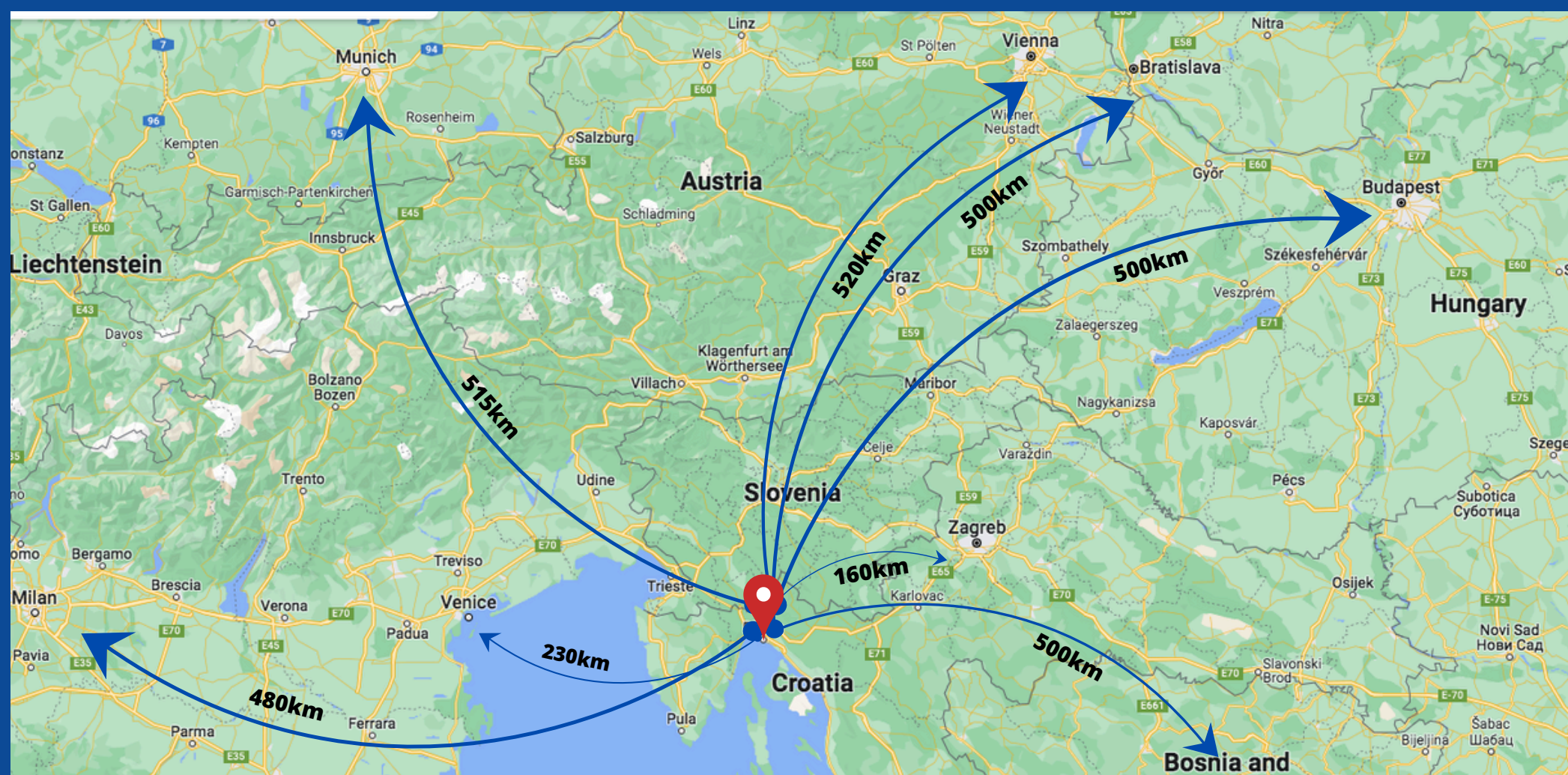

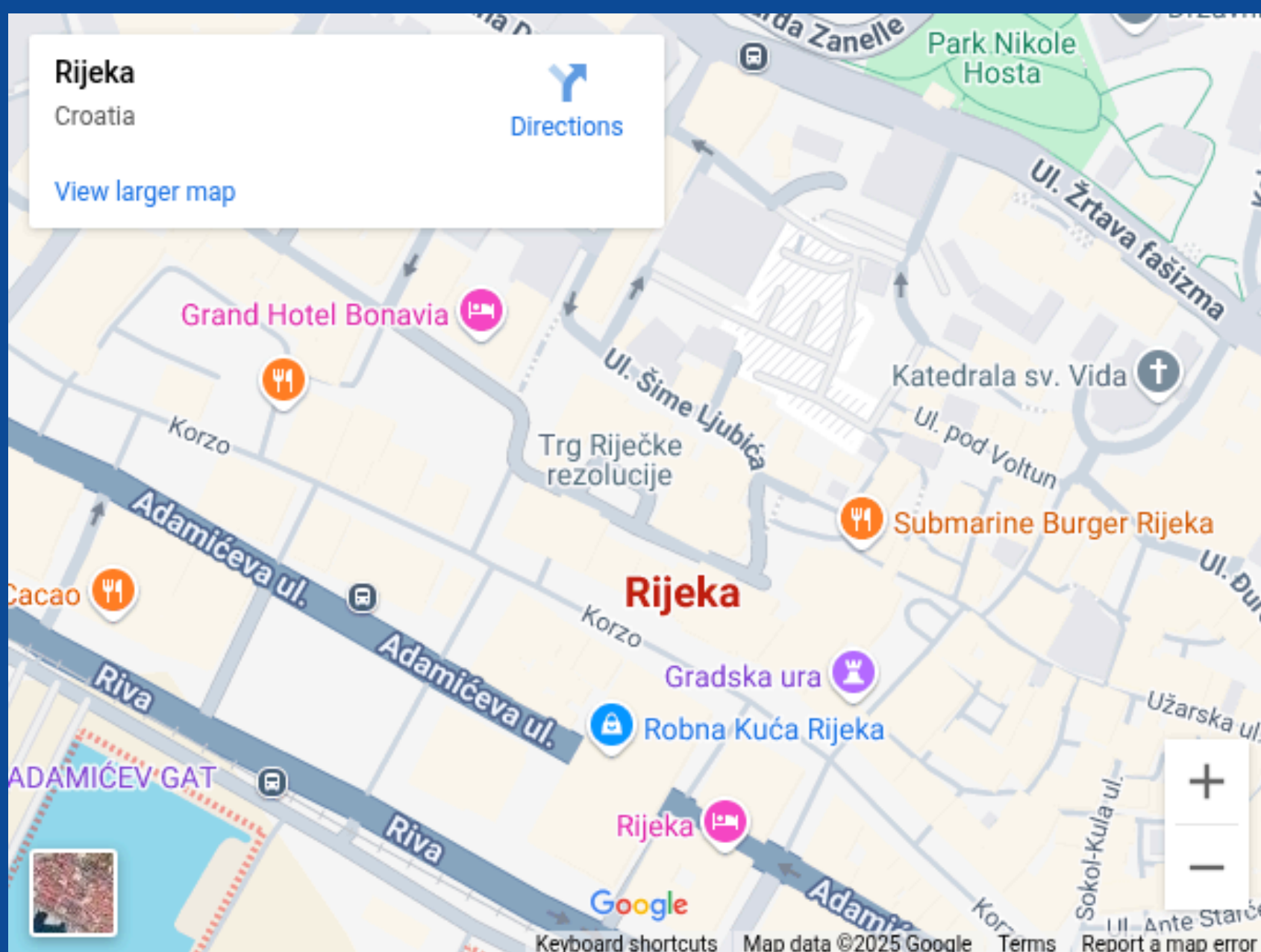


ENTRIES TO RIJEKA

IF YOU COME VIA TRIESTE OR LJUBLJANA ...

Descending from Matulji towards the city center you have a magnificent view over the entire Kvarner Bay, from the mountain Učka at whose foot is situated Opatija to the islands of Krk and Cres. Your route partly involves driving on the former racing track used for motor races for the Great Adriatic Prize before Grobnik Track was constructed. By taking the straight road along the coast you will arrive at the swimming pool of the "Swimming Club Primorje" next to which is the football stadium "Kantrida" where Football Club Rijeka played its matches.

The stadium is very interesting because it was erected on the spot of the excavation made for the constructing of the city port. Following the same route, you'll be passing alongside the industrial units among which you'll notice Rijeka's shipyard "3 Maj" which sprang from the shipyard "Ganz – Danubiuz", then near a large petroleum refinery, the skyscraper of "Novi", well known daily newspaper, the town park Mlaka after which follows the hospital complex. The central of the complex is the former maritime Military Academy, the institution where the Austrian and Hungarian officers were educated from 1866 till 1918. Finally, you arrive to the railway station which is the western borderline of Rijeka's city center.



IF YOU COME FROM ZAGREB...

Driving through Grobničko polje you come to the pain where Mongols and Turks were passing in their ruthless attacks. Today here is the racing track that was taken into consideration for the race of Formula 1. Through the canyon of the river Rječina and underneath the castle of Trsat you descend by the market route of the road Luiziana, named after the daughter of the Austrian emperor and the second wife of Napoleon Marie Louise and you come to Sušak, the eastern part of the city. Beyond you are the former "Paper factory" and on the other bank of the river of Rječina, water – spring Zvir, which never drains and recently got the cupola covering.

With its 130,000 inhabitants, located on an area of only 44km², Rijeka is the largest port and third biggest city in Croatia. The base of its turbulent history and rich cultural heritage, Rijeka created its recognizable identity as an open city, a multinational and multicultural center, in which tolerance, understanding and coexistence have a special meaning and value. Rijeka has a convenient geographical and traffic location, on the spot where the Adriatic went deep into the European continent. Today Rijeka is a city of intensive development towards the tertiary or service activities. However, Rijeka intends to keep its typical economical activities, such as port activities, shipbuilding and oil processing industry. Special attention has been paid to the communal infrastructure, sustainable development and ecology. Rijeka is one of few cities from the East Adriatic Coast, which solved the problem of sea protection from pollution after the erection of Wastewater Treatment Plant.

PRIMORSKO-GORANSKA COUNTY

Primorsko-Goranska County is a unit of regional government of all citizens residing on the territory of the City of Rijeka, other 14 towns (Bakar, Crikvenica, Delnice, Kastav, Krk, Novi Vinodolski, Opatija...), as well as other 22 municipalities (Baska, Fužine, Kostrena, Lovran, Matulji, Omišalj...). The County has independence in decisions on matters of Basic info regional importance, particularly with reference to matters related to education, healthcare, town and country planning, zoning, economic development, traffic and traffic infrastructure, as well as the planning and development of a network of educational, healthcare, welfare and cultural institutions.

OPATIJA

Opatija is a town in western Croatia, just southwest of Rijeka on the Adriatic coast, population is 11,659 (2011). Opatija is situated in the Gulf of Kvarner in a sheltered position at the foot of Učka Mountain, with Vojak peak at 1401 m. The city is geographically on the Istrian peninsula, though it is not in Istria county, but Primorsko-Goranska County. It is a popular summer and winter resort, with average temperatures of 10°C in winter, and 25°C in summer.

Opatija is surrounded by beautiful woods of bay laurel. The whole sea-coast to the north and south of Opatija is rocky, picturesque and contains several smaller winter resorts. The city's most prestigious sight is the Villa Angiolina, which was built in 1844 by Iginio Scarpa, a rich merchant from Rijeka. The first hotel, the Hotel Kvarner, was built in 1884. Opatija is known for the Lady with the seagull, a statue which is positioned by the Juraj Šporer pavilion. Many towns and villages with beautiful beaches make the Opatija (or Liburnian) Riviera: Lovran, Ičići, Medveja, Mošćenička Draga and Brseč.

TRSAT

Trsat is situated on the hill above the city of Rijeka which provides unforgettable view on the entire Kvarner Bay. It is ideal place for a walk, sightseeing and for having a coffee. There is also the Shrine of Our Lady of Trsat, one of the oldest in Croatia, that was visited by the Pope John Paul II in June 2003. In his honor, the monument of The Holy Father –The Pilgrim of Trsat was built in the shrine, the work of the sculptor Ante Jurkić.

ISLAND OF KRK

Krk is the second largest island in Adriatic Sea and the most populated with 19,383 inhabitants in multiple towns and villages among which the most known are Omišalj, Njivice, Malinska, City of Krk, Punat, Baška, Vrbnik, Dobrinj, Šilo and Klimno. It is situated on east of Kvarner Bay and the distance between Rijeka and center of Krk is 47km. It has historical and geographical meaning. Island of Krk is ideal place for sightseeing, vacation, hiking, swimming and other activities.

CITY OF ZAGREB

Zagreb is the capital and the largest city of Croatia. Zagreb is the cultural, scientific, economic and governmental center of the Republic of Croatia. The city's population in 2011 was 790,017 (estimated more than a million in the metropolitan area). It is situated between the southern slopes of the Medvednica Mountain and both northern and southern bank of the Sava river. The transport connections, concentration of industry, scientific and research institutions and industrial tradition underlie its leading economic position in Croatia. Zagreb is the main residence of the central government, administrative bodies and almost all government ministries. Being an important junction point, Zagreb has road, air, railway and bus connections with other European metropolises and all bigger cities and tourist resorts in Croatia.

Some of you asked us about taxi transportation. In the center of the town there are three taxi terminals:


- at the main Bus Terminal
- in Matije Gupca Street,
- at the railway station.

The minimal price in Rijeka, for less than 5 km is 5 EUR, but it varies depending on the providers. Taxi Fiume (+38551 515 515) and Wizi (+38551 313-313) are two cheapest so make sure you ask about the price before getting into the taxi because there are also those charging more (5€). Uber is covering the area of Rijeka and Opatija. You have the possibility to install Uber, Wizi or Bolt application and use that kind of taxi transport.

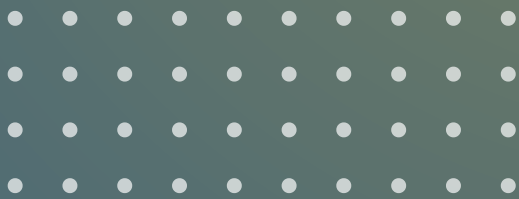
