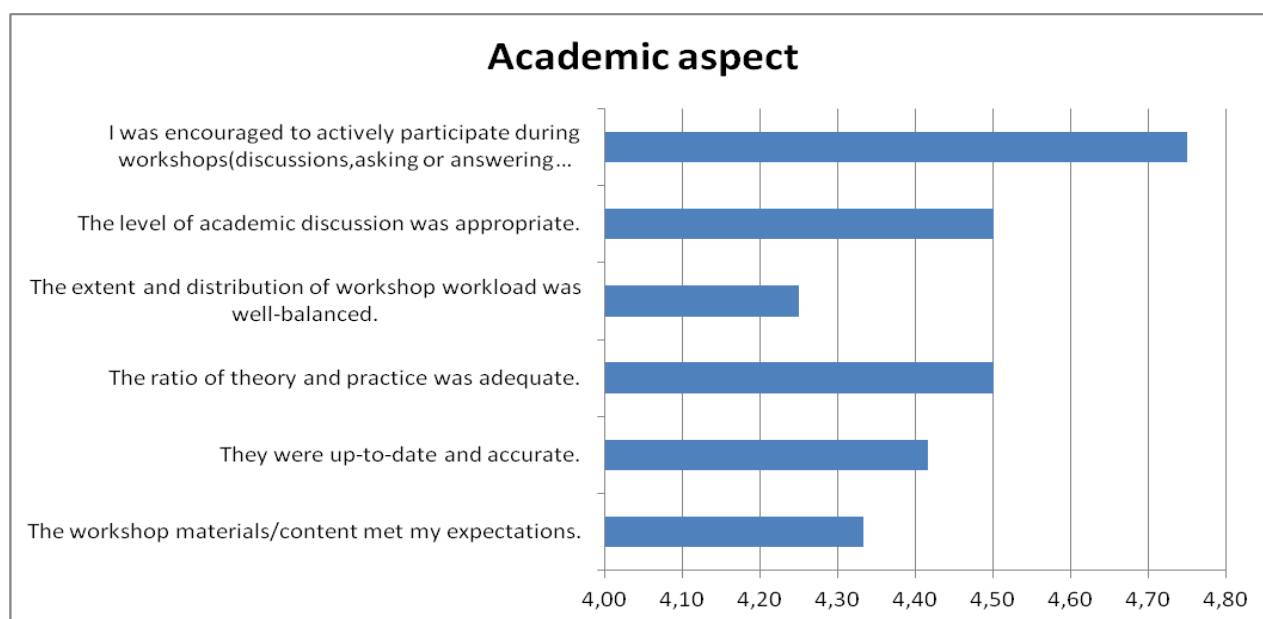
### EFRI IBW 2016

#### **1<sup>st</sup> part: Evaluation**

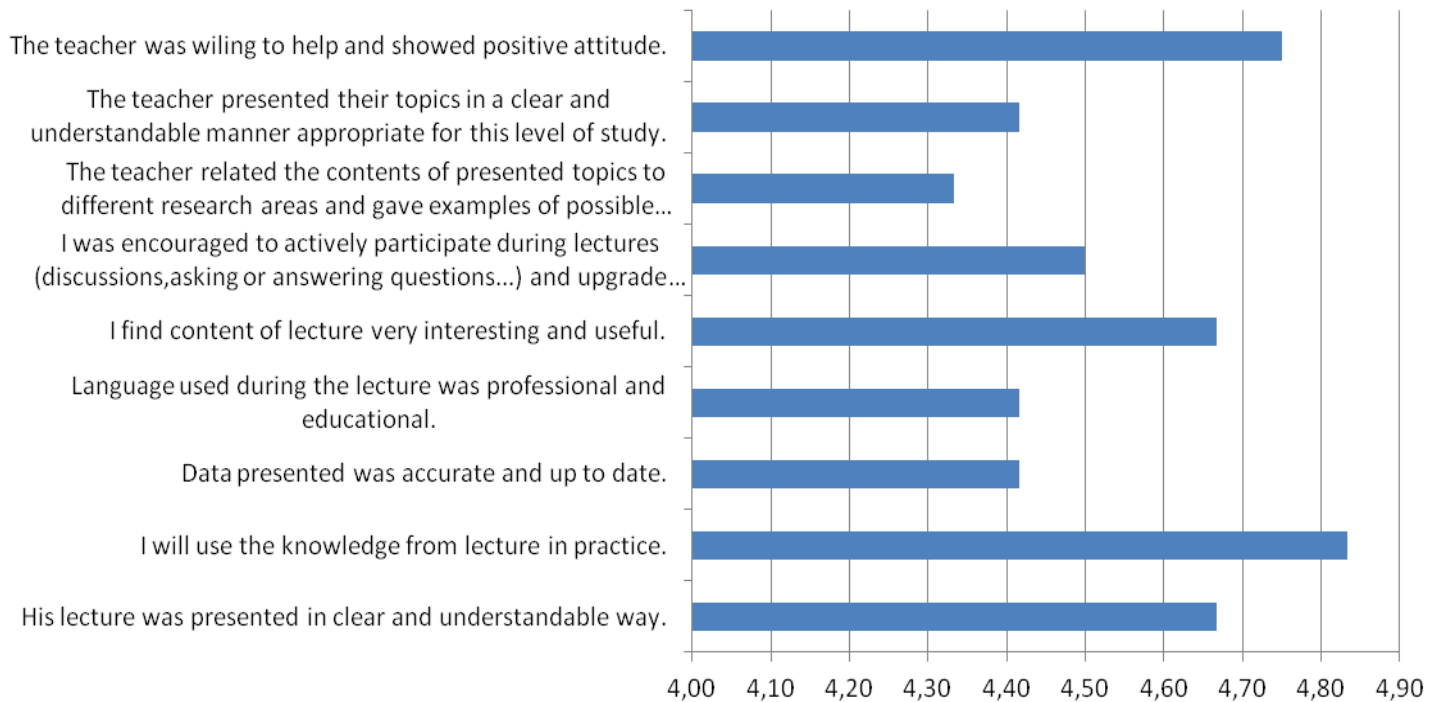
